Also, one of the guys collaborates directly with NOGAP.

The associations involved are united by a abolitionist approach on the issue of prostitution, LIKEwhich the one that underlies the actions of the Mouvement du Nid and which brought France, in 2016, to become the fourth European country that punishes customers, after Sweden, Norway and Iceland.

In 2022, a campaign designed to Raise awareness has



been launched via our social networks on the projects' theme; a complex and delicate theme, which crosses areas such as stigma, trauma, violence, the gap of gender, fear of victims, trivializationoperated by the media, the economy and the dynamics of power. The Campaign is viewable on our Facebook page e on our Instagram channel. Also, we elaborated information sheets on gender-based violence and

prostitution which in 2023 will be translated into 4 languages and published.

Also in 2022, as part of the project, two important mobilities were carried out: in Argentina, Mexico and French Guiana where NOGAP could attend thanks to three operators.

The project explores the potential of learning socio-emotional skills as a response to Social Anxiety Disorder: one of the most common disorders among young people especially during adolescence and beyond, increasing between the general population as a result of the social distance imposed by the Covid19 pandemic.

STOP! WORDS in PROGRESS: We start from the strength of narration to develop paths and modules, crossing and integrating different sectors (Theatre/Journalism and Music), in order to make young people work on the 5 skills (Emotional Awareness, Self-regulation, Ability to make decisions responsible, Relational skills, Social Awareness) which facilitated precisely socio-emotional learning.



Two operators' meetings were held in 2022 in order to focus on the following techniques:

- Storytelling and tree of life
- Theater of the oppressed
- Journalistic theater
- Psycho-drama
- Sung stories

IThe first workshop, lasting three days, was hosted by the STORYTELLING Center and (23 – 25 March 2022) involved 13 operators.

The second workshop, also lasting three days, was hosted by NOGAP (August 3 - 8, 2022) and involved 12 operators and 6 guys.

The action analyzes the potential of social agriculture in the rehabilitation of vulnerable subjects by deepening the aspects of a THERAPEUTIC GARDEN, specifically designed to meet physical, psychological, social and spiritual needs of the people who use it, as well astheir caregivers, family and friends.

The purposes of the project are to:

- Increase the educators' skills and tools for the Rehabilitation of vulnerable people (and specifically women)
- Facilitate understanding, in educators, of the intersectionality between



eco-approach/health/acquisition of skills and therapy

- Strengthen the offer of tools and paths that promote learning and rehabilitation of people in situations of vulnerability through social agriculture and gardening.
- Contribute to EU awareness and dialogue on mental health, gender-based violence and inclusion social.

BENEFICIARIES: at least 32 boys and girls in situations of vulnerability and at least 16 educators.

Green HealthIn 2022, the Project hosted an initial

training meeting in Italy (6-8 April 2022) which saw the involvement of 5 among male and female operators and focused on the introduction of the concepts of horticultural therapy and some applied exercises, on the presentation of the Big Five model to identify resilient personalities within the staff and thus prevent the burn-out, on the creative design thinking technique for the design of a therapeutic garden and on basic notions of circular economy.

A second training was held in Portugal (13-15 July 2022) during which the partners have defined the modules to be developed, presented the spaces where the gardens will be created, and experimented with scientific illustration technique.

And explores the potential of Community Gardens as spaces of inclusion.

Specifically, the project aims to create a Garden prototype that takes into account the inclusion of vulnerable young people by combining the planning of GREEN HEALTH on therapeutic gardens and the planning of STOP! WORDs in PROGRESS that analyzes social anxiety disorder.

BENEFICIARIES: at least 12 educators

In 2022 the project guaranteed two mobilities: one in Rome (June 16-18, 2022) in order to plan activities and to define the criteria for the design of the prototype, and one in Paris to study strengths and criticality of the project and to define the organization of the Hackathon.



In October each partner organized a Hackathon in their own country, involving 15 young people and dividing them into 3 teams. All teams have designed their ideal community garden, beginning from some words stimulus that organizations involved had previously selected during the mobility in Paris. In every country a winner has been chosen and a small "thank you price" was given to all participants for taking part to the initiative

An online meeting was held in November In order to share the winning projects, with the purpose of integrating some of the elements proposed in the prototype.



OUR FUTURE PERSPECTIVES

2023 will be for NOGap the year in which the guys will be directly involved in projects implementation. It will be an evaluation year that will allow us to make important considerations on new investments and the impact of certain actions.

2023 will see:

- The beginning of TAKE PART! A new project centered on ART and ACTIVISM with new European partners that will integrate into our network. It is a project of strong communication.
- The structuring of the Organizational Plan of the association, which will be accessible to all members and which will define the various roles, and further on the structuring of the Scientific Committee: an entity that will have the role of research, analysis, experimentation and connection with the university and experimental world
- The launch of the GREEN HEALTH workshop. We will work directly with the

- guys on a pilot project on a space that is self-managed by the guys themselves. We will work on the management and creation of individual vegetable gardens, we will visits to thematic nurseries to discover national educational and social realities, we will define an annual calendar of workshops based on circular economy, in addition to the self-creation of a space ofoutdoor therapy. The Scientific Committee will launch the first pilot space its own project relating to individual gardens.
- The start of the sung story workshop coordinated by Michele Marchesani. The guys will be guided into the creation of stories that will be put into music.

NOGap will also:

- Guarantee a greater presence with 3 days a week: Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday;
- Analyze the possibility of integrating two more therapeutic internships in its own staff;
- Continue to work on creating partnerships and project proposals;
- Finish enrollment in RUNTS and start the campaign for the donation of 5×1000;
- Analyze the possibility of starting a first daytime space that can offer the guys to exit the Lahuen community in a protected professional re-entry space;
