Description:

The **WeLENS** project aims to contribute to citizens' critical understanding of the global interdependencies underlying gender-based violence and sexual exploitation. The project aims to explore the root causes of this phenomenon from a perspective that takes into consideration the specificities it takes on in the different countries involved. The objective is to raise awareness among social workers so that they can acquire new knowledge from a perspective of interconnection between the different types of violence that emerge in the various countries involved.

Target group:

19 professionals and 45 women victims of gender-based violence from different countries of the world (Martinique, France, Greece, Italy, Estonia, Argentina, Mexico, Guyana), who all have a traumatic experience related to abuse.

Theme:

To promote awareness on the topic of global interdependencies behind gender-based violence and sexual exploitation



Objectives:

- Design interdisciplinary and interglobal educational modules and professional tools on gender-based violence and sexual exploitation;
- Build and strengthen the capacities of EU and non-EU organizations to devise and develop appropriate strategies to address the challenge of gender-based violence;
- Promote strategic cross-border cooperation and networking among organizations from EU member states and non-EU countries;
- Promote women's commitment to gender-sensitive communication through positive messages that stimulate emotional memory;
- Facilitate people's awareness and access to deeper and more meaningful information on global and domestic interdependencies to gender-based violence and sexual exploitation.
