Our first year

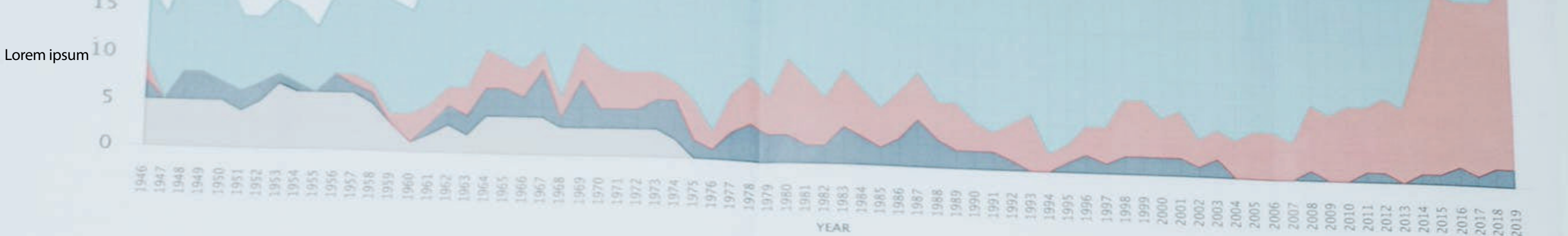
WHEN

The organization was born on January 17, 2020: exactly one month before the start of the COVID 19 epidemic from which we are still struggling to get out.

This meant to have blocked:

- the opportunity to let us know
- to create moments of dialogue and exchange with the Orvieto community
- to participate in events organized by others associations, to organize meetings and think about laboratories.

In addition, it has limited "recreational" moments and knowledge of the NOGap group of volunteers so fundamental for an associative climate.





DESPITE IT ALL...

1. We manage to work within the Lahuén Community thanks to the coordination with the administration which allowed:

- swabs
- a dedicated space to meet youth
- an office in Via dei Cedri 5.

2. We have created a working group that integrates operators from the Community and external staff.

3. We guaranteed a constant presence with a weekly meeting every Tuesday at 9.00

4. From 7 founding members we have reached 63 registered members.

OUR PROJECTS

We have TWO active PROJECTS:

- **An internship for...** to ensure internship for youth from the Lahuén Community;
- **the ACT-UP!** project aimed at strengthening the skills and knowledge of organizations, with respect to the issue of human trafficking and sexual exploitation co-financed by the Erasmus Plus programme, Key Action KA2 – Cooperation for innovation and exchange of good practices – Capacity Building in the youth field.

In addition, THREE laboratories:

- **L'Orizzonte:** where young people experiment with drafting an online newspaper with different headings;
- **The the SOuL key music laboratory** that allows to work on emotion and music;
- **Social Hackademy Lab** aimed at acquiring digital skills in partnership with ENGINA of Foligno.

Furthermore:

- **We had managed to activate the first NOGaperitifs** (then interrupted due to COVID-19)
- **We tried the enrollment of FOUR youth in the Civil Service:**

A first chance to experience and to understand the importance of first interviews e acceptance of failure when experimenting with any job search.
